This Week's Program



Head coach Pete D'Amour led the Hokies to their second ever appearance in the NCAA Super Regionals during the 2021 campaign, doing so in just his second full season. Selected for the NCAA Tournament in both full seasons as head coach, D'Amour's Hokies were the No. 2 seed at the 2021 Tempe Regional with national No. 15 seed Arizona State as the group's favorite. Tech emerged from the four-team regional undefeated under D'Amour's guidance, the first time

in school history that the Hokies' swept an

NCAA Regional.

2021 was not just a historic year for the Hokies, but for D'Amour as well as he became the fastest head coach in program history to reach 100 wins, doing so in just 127 games. Under D'Amour's tutelage, pitcher Keely Rochard became Tech's third NFCA All-American ever and just the second to earn first-team honors. D'Amour and his wife Anna also welcomed their first son, Reaux, to the world prior to the NCAA Tournament.
