

Stuffing mix (2 boxes)

Rice (1 small bag)
Green beans or peas (2 cans)
Yams or sweet potatoes (2 cans OR 1 large can)
Corn (2 cans)
Cranberry sauce (1 can)
Biscuit or cornbread mix (2 packages)
Instant mashed potatoes (1 box)
Tea bags or Hot chocolate mix (1 box of family-sized bags)
Gravy mix (1 packet)
Soup (2 cans of cream of mushroom)
