Are you interested in being our District Governor for 2024-2025? Club recommendations are being accepted by the District Nominating Committee. Club recommendations must be submitted on the Rotary International Governor-Nominee Form and Governor-Nominee Data Form, both found here. The form includes the club's statement of the candidate's qualifications certified by the Club Secretary and based on a resolution adopted at a regular meeting of the sponsoring club.

Along with the Governor-Nominee Form, the suggested candidate may include a summary of their Rotary positions served, activities, recognition, civic organizations served other than Rotary, and other items relevant to the District Governor position. The summary should be no more than two pages. Club recommendations must be received by District Secretary Tim Carter no later than October 29, 2021 via email or mailed to him at: 528 Old School House Drive Maurertown, VA 22644. District Secretary Tim will review the forms for completeness and forward to the Nominating Committee. Interviews will be held at the Bristol Hotel on November 6.
