# **FACTS & FIGURES**



Fire Departments responded to over 2.700 calls for service.



Rescue Squads responded to more than 11,600 calls for service.

The Sheriff's Office responded to more than 31,000 calls for service, served more than 23,000 civil processes, and conducted nearly 700 traffic crash investigations.

The Sheriff's Office Civil Division worked nearly 930 court sessions.

Animal Care and Adoption Center achieved a 95.7% live release rate. In FY2022, more than 1,600 pets were adopted, reclaimed, or rescued. Volunteers provided over 5,000 hours of service.

The Voter Registrar's Office registered more than 61,000 voters for November 2021 General Election. There were over 8,600 absentee inperson (early voting) voters and close to 3,500 absentee (mailed) voters.



In April of 2022, the Montgomery County Board of Supervisors approved a \$90 million bond issuance for Christiansburg High School renovations.


