The Montgomery County Christmas Store (MCCS) is a non-denominational, all-volunteer, community-wide, non-profit organization that assists eligible low-income individuals and families in Montgomery County during the Christmas Season by providing a shopping experience characterized by choice and dignity. To shop at the Christmas Store, a person must:

- 1) Have an income not greater than 125% of the federal poverty guidelines.
- 2) Be a resident of Montgomery County, AND
- 3) Meet one or more of the following criteria:
 - a. Have school-aged children in the home
 - b. Have adults 62 years of age or older in the home
 - c. Receive some type of disability income


