This Week's Program



When Virginia Tech head wrestling coach Tony Robie came to Blacksburg in 2006, he was an associate head coach who inherited a barren program that had the potential to be great. Progressively he helped build the Hokies into one of the top programs in the ACC and a mainstay in the top 10 nationally. Four full seasons into his tenure as head coach, Robie is still leading the Hokies into new territory.

Robie led the Hokies to a historic season in 2020-21, piloting the first undefeated season in program history since 1956-57. At 9-0, the Hokies completed their longest undefeated

season in program history under Robie's guidance, topping 1954-55's 8-0 mark. With the feat, Robie joined Frank Teske, George Herring and S.B. Sutton. Tech won its fourth ACC Dual Meet Title after posting a perfect 5-0 ACC dual record, the second such title in Robie's tenure and fourth ACC Championship with Robie at the helm.
