My name is Matt Shortt and I am a native to Virginia, I was born and raised in Abingdon, VA. I first arrived in Blacksburg in 2000, where I attended Virginia Tech for my undergrad, majoring in Science of Human Nutrition, Foods, and Exercise. I then relocated to Roanoke, to attend Jefferson College of Health Sciences for my Physician Assistant training and subsequently earned my MBA from Johns Hopkins Carey School of Business. I have been an active youth athletics coach with Blacksburg Parks and Rec for the past 4 years and I am excited to be an assistant softball coach with Blacksburg Middle School beginning this year.

I am very excited to be part of the Rotary Club of Blacksburg and to be able to contribute to the outstanding history of community support and service, but also the ability to influence change on a global scale. I am also very thankful for the family involvement in which Rotary embraces, allowing my children to be part of something bigger and to support their community from a young age.
