### Join This Week's Meeting

This week, we hope you'll join us to learn more about Dr. Cohen's work and research on addressing water, wastewater, and health related challenges in lower-income regions of Appalachia.

## About This Week's Program

Dr. Alasdair Cohen is an Assistant Professor of Environmental Epidemiology in the Department of Population Health Sciences and the Public Health Program at Virginia Tech (VT). He also has an affiliate faculty appointment in the Department of Civil & Environmental Engineering at VT, and serves as Research Director for the Berkeley/China/Virginia Tech Program for Water & Health (www.RuralWaterHealth.org). Cohen earned his PhD in Environmental Science, Policy, & Management, and an MPH in Epidemiology, from the University of California, Berkeley, as well as an MSc in Water Science, Policy, & Management from the University of Oxford.

Dr. Cohen's overarching goal is to help advance programs and policies for improving drinking water (treatment, supply, and access), sanitation, and health in lower-income rural areas. He and his group collaborate with government agencies, international institutions, non-profits, universities, and others to conduct field- and desk-based research internationally and domestically. He has 15+ years of research and project management experience, and has worked for three United Nations (UN) agencies, primarily leading projects to develop and evaluate water-and-poverty focused indicators to support rural poverty reduction projects.

Since 2006, he has designed and managed the implementation of six large-scale (>400 households) field-based research projects in Bangladesh, China, India, and Mozambique with UN, government, and academic collaborators. In particular, he designed and managed a UN-led project to create The Multidimensional Poverty Assessment Tool (www.IFAD.org/MPAT), an open-source, survey-based monitoring and evaluation tool that has since been used in numerous countries. Since 2013,

he has also collaborated with various agencies at the Chinese Center for Disease Control and Prevention (China CDC) to conduct drinking water and health focused research in low-income rural areas of China.

Currently, Cohen is leading two small-scale water-and-health focused prospective cohort studies, as well as a wastewater focused project, in southwest Virginia. Building on initial findings from this and other research, he is now working on a number of proposals to better understand and help address water, wastewater, and health related challenges in lower-income regions of Appalachia.
