# What is a Gold Club Award?



The purpose of the Gold Club Award is to provide a path towards a well-managed club and create a focus on Rotary International's areas of focus. It includes activities that every club should be doing to be an active, functioning club. The program was started in 2009 by then District Governor Ron Napier (RC of Front Royal) and the Blacksburg Rotary Club has achieved Gold Club status every year since. It a road map to help an incoming president plan his/her year.

There are 28 mandatory activities to complete each year and 3-6 elective activities, depending on the size of your club, in five

categories. The categories are leadership, membership, foundation, service, and public image. As a club between 70-99 members, we need to complete five activities each year. The Gold Club year follows the Rotary year but there are deadlines outside of the year for a new president to complete.

This year we are only missing one mandatory item, and that is to have 70% of our members contribute to the Rotary Foundation. To date, we have had 29 members make their donation. We still need 37 of you to step up to the plate and make a donation of any size to the Foundation that funds our district grants and does so much good around the world. It is not a tough decision! 
