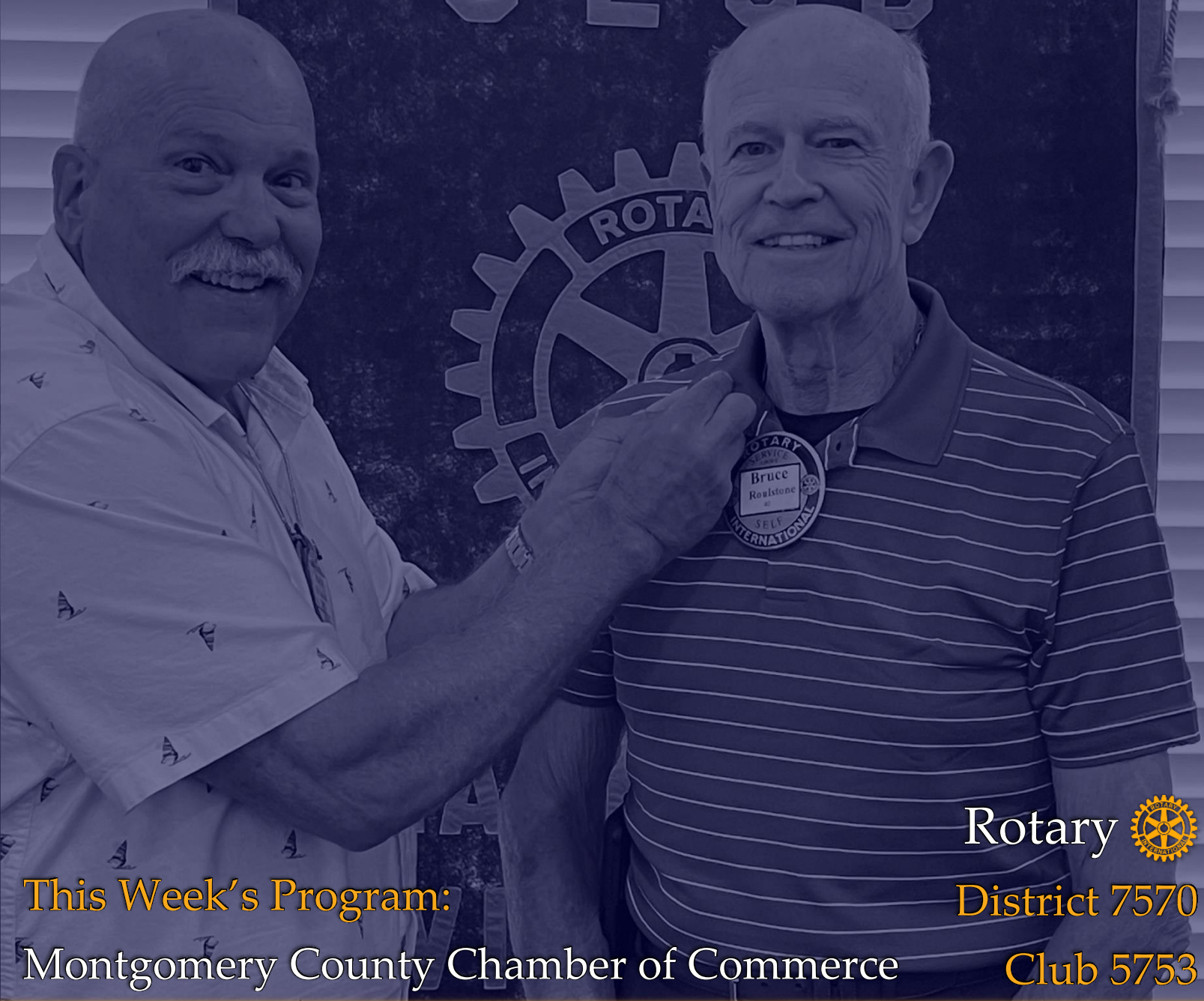

Sponsorships and Other Announcements

100% of your sponsorship dollars go to the Local Foundation and count as your annual donation.

- \$20 for 1 Week Sponsorship
- \$50 for 1 Month Sponsorship (Limit 3 Per Sponsor per Rotary Year)
 - Runs every week for a calendar month.
 - Guaranteed to appear in at least 4 bulletins (will flow over to future available weeks in the event less than 4 bulletins are done in that month)
- \$135 for 3 Month Sponsorship (Limit 1 Per Sponsor per Rotary Year)
 - Guaranteed to appear in at least 12 bulletins total during current Rotary year.
 - Sponsor can decide if weeks should appear consecutively or spread out.
- \$300 for Gold Sponsor (1 Max)
 - Runs every week for 3 calendar months.
 - Months do not have to be consecutive.
 - Runs in additional weeks, as available, until it has been shown at least 20 weeks total during the current Rotary year.
 - After being shown 20 weeks, logo will continue to be shown in any week where no other sponsor is available.
 - Deadline for current Rotary year – 9/30/2021
- \$800 for Platinum Sponsor (1 Max)
 - Runs every week for a Rotary year.
 - Deadline to apply for Current Rotary Year – 7/31/2021
 - If there is a platinum sponsor, there will be no other sponsorships available.
 - Physical Sign at Meeting (Near Badges) recognizing sponsor at every meeting.
