Virginia Tech/Montgomery Executive Airport officials report a recent runway expansion is having major economic impact. Airport officials report with the extra 1,000 feet -- 4,500 feet to 5,500 feet -- added to the runway, it's opening doors for more corporate aircraft to access the businesses they have in our region.

Keith Holt has been the director for the Virginia Tech/Montgomery Executive Airport for about a year. Holt says about 75% of existing corporate air aircraft fleets in the United States can now land and take off right here. The airport is run by the Virginia Tech Montgomery Regional Airport Authority, which is comprised of representatives from Virginia Tech, Montgomery County, Blacksburg and the Town of Christiansburg.
