Today's Program - Kenny Brooks, VT Women's Basketball

Kenny Brooks was named the seventh head women's basketball coach in Virginia Tech women's basketball history on March 28, 2016 and concluded his seventh season at the helm of the Hokies' program in 2023.

Since Brooks' arrival in Blacksburg, the Hokies have enjoyed seven consecutive winning seasons, and made three consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament. Tech has posted numerous records when it comes to ACC win totals, ranked wins and athletes earning postseason accolades.

Brooks led the Hokies to the program's first ACC title in 2023 and earned a one seed in the NCAA Tournament. In a remarkable run, the Hokies defeated Chattanooga and South Dakota State in Cassell Coliseum and Tennessee and Ohio State in Seattle to advance to the Final Four.



His seventh season was one full of milestones and program bests as the Hokies went 14-4 in ACC play to earn a coveted double bye in the ACC Tournament.

Tech went 16-1 at home with the lone loss coming to a top five team. The Hokies defeated eight ranked teams, a program record for a single season.

The Waynesboro, Virginia native was a finalist for the Werner Ladder Naismith Women's College Coach of the Year in 2023 after achieving a slew of program firsts, that also included the first 30-win season (31).


