Do Less Work in your Yard this Autumn


Advice from your Environmental Committee

Many species of butterflies and other beneficial insects could overwinter in your yard if you allow them to do so. They do so in leaf litter or on vegetation. They overwinter as eggs, caterpillars, chrysalises, or even as adult butterflies.

All you have to do is don't rake all of your yard; and, if you have a garden, resist cleaning it all up until May. As naturalist Debra Graf says: Don't create a desert during a time of year that beneficial insects need shelter and protection." "Tolerate a bit of messiness." As your bonus, the leaves will be useful much mulch by Spring.

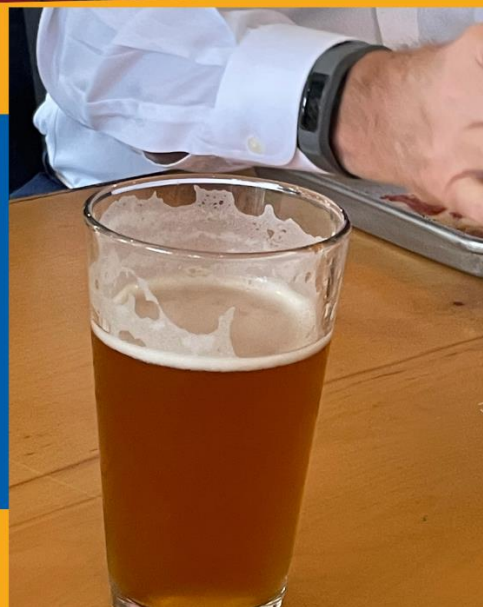
